
THE SYNTHETIC OPIOID EPIDEMIC

SYNTHETIC OPIOID OVERDOSE DEATHS REPRESENT THE MAJORITY OF DRUG-RELATED DEATHS OUT OF ALL ILLICIT DRUGS IN THE U.S. THE GRAPHS BELOW SHOWCASE THE GROWING EPIDEMIC NATIONALLY COMPARED TO THE STATE OF GEORGIA.

What are synthetic opioids?

Synthetic opioids are man-made and are not derived from plant material. Fentanyl is the most prevelant and significant synthetic opioid. Others include fentanyl analogs and tramadol.


Age-adjusted rates of drug overdose deaths involving synthetic opioids other than methadone: United States, 2013-2020



The rate of drug overdose deaths involving synthetic opioids (primarily fentanyl) increased 56% from 2019 to 2020.

Synthetic opioids such as fentanyl accounted for nearly 73% of all opioid-involved deaths in 2019.

Age-adjusted rates of drug overdose deaths involving synthetic opioids other than methadone: Georgia, 2016-2019
